## Day One:

**K,1,2**- Pick one of your speech sounds and think of four words that have the sound in the beginning of the word. You can find a partner to help you. Example. D - Duck

**3,4,5** - Pick one of your speech sounds and think of 8-10 words that have the sound in the beginning of the word. You can find a partner to help you. Use those words in sentences.

## Day Two:

**K,1,2** - As you eat a meal, share with a family member about one of your speech sounds.

**3,4,5** - See how many words have your speech that occur during the meal. Using your good speech sound productions, use those words in sentences and conversations during the meal.

## Day Three:

**K,1,2** - Go on a walk in your neighborhood, sit in your backyard, or look out the window. Observe all of the nature around you. Try and find as many things as you can that include your target sound. Say each word 5 times.

**3,4,5** - Do the same activity above, but try to find at least 10-15 words that have your target sound. Say each word five times while hopping on one foot, jumping up and down, spinning in a circle or whatever other action you can think of!
